

1. Copy of your current membership card.
2. If you do not have a current membership card, complete the application you received or download from <http://scca.cdn.racersites.com/prod/Documents/Club%20Forms/sccamemberapp.pdf> with a check for the appropriate fees for membership made out to the SCCA.
3. Completed license application with a check made out for the appropriate fees made out to the SCCA. The form can be found at [http://scca.cdn.racersites.com/prod/assets/full%20competition%20license\\_fillable.pdf](http://scca.cdn.racersites.com/prod/assets/full%20competition%20license_fillable.pdf)
4. Completed current physical form <http://scca.cdn.racersites.com/prod/assets/Physical.pdf>
5. A short resume of your racing experience along with documentation (results, letters, diplomas, etc. from accredited SCCA racing schools), types of cars raced, organizations, Novice Permit and type of car you are going to race.
6. What level of license you are applying for, Full Competition or Novice <http://scca.cdn.racersites.com/prod/Documents/Club%20Forms/form-noviceapp.pdf> .
7. A separate check for \$25 made out to Great Lakes Division, SCCA. This is the waiver processing fee.
8. Include an envelope addressed to SCCA Membership Services, P.O. Box 299 Topeka, KS 66601-0299. Make sure it has appropriate postage as well.
